**September 3-5 2014, Belgrade, Serbia**

The **Milankovitch Anniversary UNESCO Symposium Water Management in Transition Countries as Impacted by Climate and Other Global Changes, Lessons from Paleoclimate, and Regional Issues** will take place in Belgrade, Serbia, from September 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

The symposium, organised by the “Jaroslav Cerni” Institute for Development of Water Resources, Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts, and WSDAC - Water for Sustainable Development and Adaptation to Climate Change Centre, will be held under the auspices of the Serbian Government and UNESCO.

The first day activities will have the form of a plenary session at the Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts, Belgrade.

1. Regional climate modeling (RCM) issues
2. Mediterranean and SE Europe climate change
3. Added value via RCM use
4. Domain size and lateral boundary conditions
5. Verification: how well are we doing?

Deadline for submission of abstracts is April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Authors will be notified of the selection by May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

Deadline for submission of full papers is July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2014.
